

C.S. Lewis Square

Greenways are traffic-free routes for use by pedestrians and cyclists and they provide an amenity suitable for people of all abilities due to smooth surfaces and wide paths. The **Connswater Community Greenway (CCG)** is 16km of continuous cycle and walkway through east Belfast and is a valuable asset for schools in the surrounding areas.

C.S. Lewis Square acts as a central point on the Greenway and can be used as a meeting point before exploring the rest of the Greenway in either direction, to Victoria Park or Orangefield Park.

- **Getting there:** We advise the use of public transport and active travel to get to C.S. Lewis Square.
 - You can walk or cycle along the Connswater Community Greenway to access the space.
 - The Square is also easily accessible by bike from the City Centre via Titanic Quarter and Victoria Park. There is a Belfast Bike docking station at C.S. Lewis Square.
 - Public transport options (from city centre):
 - i. G1 Glider and get off at Hollywood Arches.
 - ii. Metro bus number 3b, c and e and get off at Connswater
 - iii. Metro bus number 3a and f and get off at Ribble Street
- **Parking:** There is limited car parking available at C.S. Lewis Square.
- **Toilet facilities:** Public toilets are available at the Hollywood Arches Library near C.S. Lewis Square and in the EastSide Visitor Centre located at the square.
- **Health & safety:** There is a public access defibrillator for use at Hollywood Arches Library beside the Square
- **Refreshments:** Located on the ground floor of EastSide Visitor Centre on C.S. Lewis Square, JACK Coffee Bar offers amazing coffee and treats

What to do?

EastSide Visitor Centre is full of information on east Belfast's key attractions, famous faces and places.

From here you can pick up one of our many trails and maps including two C.S. Lewis Square maps which will allow you to explore the space.



As you explore C.S. Lewis Square and the surrounding areas and paths, you will see a number of statues from 'The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe', the first and best known of seven novels in 'The Chronicles of Narnia' series. These include:

- Mr Tumnus
- Mr and Mrs Beaver
- Maugrim
- The White Witch
- The Robin
- Aslan the Lion!
