Flora Street Walkway

Greenways are traffic-free routes for use by pedestrians and cyclists and they provide an amenity suitable for people of all abilities due to smooth surfaces and wide paths.

The Connswater Community Greenway (CCG) is 16km of continuous cycle and walkway through east Belfast and is a valuable asset for schools in the surrounding areas. The path along the Greenway is accessible due to the smooth surfaces, dropped curbs where road crossing is required, wide paths and clearly labelled signage.

- Flora Street Walkway connects the Connswater Retail Park to the the Hollow via Elmgrove Primary school and is one of the main sections of the Greenway that also features a playpark.
- Getting there: Flora Street Walkway can be accessed on foot via the Greenway from:
 - o The Beersbridge Road
 - The Connswater Retail Park.
 - Mill Bridge at Bloomfield Parade
 - The Flora Street gate entrance

- Parking: there is no parking available at Flora Street Walkway but it is within a short walk from Connswater Retail Park and Avoniel Leisure Centre both offering car parking facilities
- Toilet facilities: Toilets are available at the Avoniel Leisure Centre
- Facilities: Flora Street Play Park is situated along the Flora Street Walkway alongside a MUGA (Multi Use Game Area)
